

## **Finding a Physician**

Finding a physician who is willing to accept Federal Worker's Compensation patients can be difficult. After an employee gets injured on the job, the employee should contact their physician and inform them that they are a postal employee that just got injured on the job, and they would like to know if their doctor takes Federal Workers Compensation claims. If your doctor does not take Federal Worker's Compensation claims, you can now search <http://owcp.dol.acs-inc.com/portal/main.do> for a doctor near your work location or home that does take federal workers compensation claims. All the doctors on the list accept Federal Worker's Compensation, so some of the doctors on the list are going to be postal contract doctors. When you contact the doctor be sure to ask the doctor if they are a postal contract physician. Remember you are not required to see a postal contract physician for your injury. If they are, it is important to note these postal contract physicians are listed because they accept federal workers compensation employees.
